

Culver High School Vehicle Registration Form

Culver High School students are expected to register their vehicles. Students who park in VISITOR, MAINTAINANCE STAFF, other specifically designated parking spaces, or in areas not designated for parking, are subject to disciplinary action, including fines, suspension of on campus parking privileges, and towing. All vehicles must be driven at or below 10 miles per hour and in a safe and non-disruptive manner while on-campus or while on the streets adjacent to the Culver School District properties. Permission to drive to campus and/or park on campus may be revoked at any time due to a driving infraction or if a student does not maintain good standing with respect to behavior, attendance, or academic performance. In cases of serious driving infractions, law enforcement may be notified.

To maintain the privilege to drive to and park on campus, students must earn and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and be in good standing with respect to behavior and attendance. Permission to park on campus does not imply permission to leave campus during the school day.

Culver High School Lunch-time Off Campus Permission Form

Culver School District restricts students to school grounds during the school day. 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students seeking to leave campus during lunch must obtain permission from the school administration by submitting this parent/guardian request form. Students who leave campus without permission shall be subject to disciplinary action. Parents/Guardians who wish to grant permission for their student to leave campus during lunch must complete this form and return it to the main office. **To leave campus students must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, be in good standing with respect to behavior and attendance, and have this signed parent permission form on file in the office.**
