Culver School District Technology Agreement 2020-2021

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

Culver School district is committed to the use of technology and the Internet for educational purposes. Technology allows teachers to enhance and extend our curriculum in ways that were previously inconceivable. Along with the advantage of using technology also comes the need to educate students about responsibility and safety when using computers, tablets, smartphones and the Internet.

Culver School district is a 1:1 ratio with chromebooks and tablets. We are striving to use technology to enhance the learning experience in the classroom. We will provide each student with a Chromebook grades 3 thru 12 and iPads grades K thru 2. Your school will also provide students with access to the Internet and to Google Apps for Education (GAPE). Google Apps for Education include free, web-based programs providing email, word processing, spreadsheets, presentation, and collaboration tools.

Even though content from known inappropriate sites on the Internet is blocked, there is always a chance students will be exposed to inappropriate content. School staff will monitor student use of the Internet when students are at school. Parents are responsible for monitoring their child's use of the Internet when accessing programs from home. Expectations

Responsible use of Culver School District's technology resources is to be ethical, respectful, academically honest, and supportive of the district's mission. Each user has the responsibility to respect every other person in our community and on the Internet. Digital storage and electronic devices used for school purposes will be treated as extensions of the physical school space. Administrators, or their designees, may review files and communications (including electronic email) to ensure that users are using the system in accordance with school district policy. Users should not expect that files stored on district servers within Google Drive, or on hard disks will be private. Users also should understand that school servers regularly record Internet activity in log files that are available to the public under ORS 91-A: Access to Public Records and Meetings.

Some activities are expressly prohibited by law. Users are expected to abide by the generally accepted rule of network etiquette while at school and at home. The following guidelines are intended to clarify expectations for conduct, but they should not be construed as all-inclusive:

- Use of electronic devices should be consistent with Culver School District's educational objectives, mission and curriculum.
- Transmission of any material in violation of local, federal and state laws is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to: copyrighted material, licensed material, and threatening or obscene material.
- Intentional or unintentional use of networked resources to access or process proxy sites, pornographic material, explicit text or files, or files dangerous to the integrity of the network is strictly prohibited.
- Software and /or services may not be installed or downloaded on school devices without prior approval of the school's administration.
- Use of computer resources for commercial activities, product advertisement, or religious or political lobbying is prohibited.
- Users may be held personally and financially responsible for malicious or intentional damage done to network software, data, user accounts, hardware and/or unauthorized costs incurred.
- Files stored on district-managed networks, Google Apps for Education accounts, or on district assigned devices may be inspected at any time and should not be considered private.
- Materials published for electronic publication must be for educational purposes. School administrators, teachers and staff may monitor these materials to ensure compliance with content standards.
