Dear Families,

November 5, 2020

We get to open onsite, meaning nearly normal school!! You hopefully have heard about the new metrics for counties that the governor put into place on Friday, October 30, 2020. If not, here is a link to a short handout on them: [New Oregon Metrics for Opening Schools](#). Jefferson County COVID-19 cases have decreased significantly. This allows us to be “in the green” section, meaning we can have full days with students on campus.

We are working fast and furious on determining schedules, protocols, safety, cleaning, cohorts, transportation, meals, etc. Here are some basics we can share with you now, more communication will come each week.

### **STARTING DAY- Monday, November 30, 2020**

#### **ONSITE SCHOOL DAY- 8:30am – 2:30pm**

Kindergarten thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade = 5 days a week

9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grades = possible alternating days, A/B schedule, still in development, more to come

**INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL- 2 options-** more detailed information coming Friday on these options.

1. Onsite
2. Online every day through a program called Edgenuity (this is a change from our current online method)

A survey will be sent on Friday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, for you to pick the model for your child/ren.

**MEALS-** For onsite students, they will receive meals on campus. For online students, they will determine if they want meals delivered or not, via Friday’s survey.

**TRANSPORTATION-** Regular bus routes will go into effect with the regulations of masks & distancing. Routes will be posted on our district website at [www.culver.k12.or.us](http://www.culver.k12.or.us) on November 20<sup>th</sup>.

**SAFETY & COHORTS-** Students will navigate their day in their classes with the limitation of not interacting with more than 100 students per week. Students will still distance and wear face coverings as required by the State mandates.

We appreciate your patience and share in your frustration with these challenging times. We are thrilled that we get the opportunity to provide more onsite instruction and value the time with your child/children. Safety will remain a priority.
