Dear Families,

I realize this week has required incredible patience and I have the utmost compassion for trying to navigate in these uncertain times!

Last night our Governor made another declaration and here is a summary of the last 48 hours...

Governor Announces New Social Distancing Order

Monday, March 16, Governor Kate Brown released a new executive order with guidelines for social distancing that prohibits all gatherings of more than 25 people and restricts restaurants and bars to offering only take-out and delivery service for at least the next four weeks. The Governor further suggested that individuals avoid any gathering with 10 or more individuals and urged all businesses to accommodate social distancing or consider closing.

Governor's School Closure

All public schools shall close to students from March 16, 2020, through April 28, 2020 ("closure period"), unless that period is extended or terminated earlier by the Governor.

Continuation of Learning Plan

During this closure we need to deliver a continuation of learning plan:

- The plan will include a variety of strategies so that our students can continue learning and connect with their teachers and school staff;
- We recognize this will take staff time to develop and have currently set aside March 30 and 31 to organize the work for students. Work packets will be mailed home on April 1st so you should have them by April 3rd.

Extending Grab and Go Meals

We are also required to continue meal service. However, this service will now only be provided to those students who qualify for free/reduced meals. **We will be giving 5 breakfast/lunch combo meals to each student on Tuesdays.**

BUS RIDERS- We will deliver as close to your driveway/house as possible and will be having you sign waivers so we can deliver even if you aren't there.

IN TOWN STUDENTS- You will come to the cafeteria between 7:30am-9:30am and pick up your package of 5 meals.

We will continue to keep you as updated as possible with information and resources as they become available.
