FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Families,

What an incredible treat to have students back in our desks! As soon as our county numbers are less than 30 cases per 100,000, for 3 weeks, we will be able to return to full days. I eagerly look forward to that!!

In the meantime, I wanted to share a few tidbits and some of them may be a repeat but it is important information:

1. **MEALS**- Our Nutrition Services Program is operating under a program that allows ALL children in our district, ages 0 to 18, to eat for free. Income doesn't matter. Onsite students pick up their own breakfast & lunch meal pack. Distance Learners can have the meal packs delivered to their house if they live greater than 1 mile from the school district. And in town families, can walk to the cafeteria for a "Grab & Go" meal pack from 8:30-9:00am or 1:00-1:30pm every day. Contact MEALS@CULVER.K12.OR.US for questions or to sign up for delivery.

2. **TECHNOLOGY**- If your student has a damaged Chromebook, an operation error, or has a general inquiry about their technology or device...email Mr. Johnson at helpdesk@culver.k12.or.us or call and leave a message at 541-546-7515.

Leave your name, either the white label number on top of your Chromebook OR the yellow/green label number from the bottom, and a brief description of the issue.

3. **ATTENDANCE**- Attendance includes both participation in class activities and interaction with a licensed or registered teacher during a school day or interactions with educational assistants and paraprofessionals through teacher-designed and facilitated processes.

"Interaction" can be

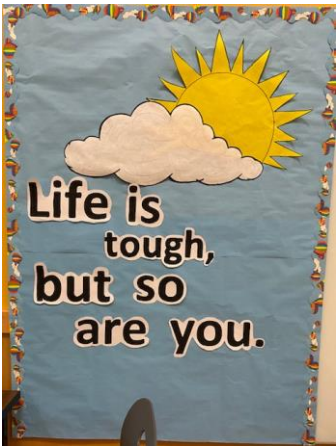
- o Participating in a video class;
- o Communication from the student to the teacher via chat, text message, communication app or email;
- o A phone call;

o Posting completed coursework to Google Classroom or email or turning in completed coursework on a given day.

METRICS AND WHEN WE GET TO GO BACK TO SCHOOL?

When can Culver School District return to full time school?

When the following are true for Jefferson County:

- Total county COVID-19 cases in the last three weeks is ≤ 30 , with less than half of cases (or ≤ 5 cases) reported in the last week of the three-week period. (adding up the last 3 weeks of cases has to be less than 30 total, and less than 15 in the last week)

Latest data =

- Week of Aug. 16 = 31 cases
- Week of Aug. 23 = 19 cases
- Week of Aug. 30 = 14 cases
- Week of Sept. 6 = 17 cases
- Week of Sept. 13 = 26 cases

- The Local Public Health Authority indicates that there is not community spread in the school catchment area.
